**Job Summary:** The **After School Illustration & Cartooning Instructor** will plan, lead, and implement an after school Illustration & Cartooning elective as part of WHEDco's After School Enrichment program at PS/MS 218. Activities should strengthen self-esteem, practice design process and skills, foster positive expression and enhance personal growth of program participants.

## **Responsibilities:**

- In cooperation with the Program Director, develop an Illustration & Cartooning component of the WHEDco After School Enrichment Program, working with grades 3-8.
- Supervise and provide guidance to program participants in the Illustration & Cartooning program elective.
- Lead an Illustration & Cartooning program that fosters positive expression, builds self-esteem and personal growth, while developing design and technical skills that exercise critical thinking.
- Assist in the planning of workshops and special events.
- Create lesson plans; select necessary supplies.
- Attend all required professional development training.
- Attend all required staff/planning meetings.
- Take on special assignments, as needed, which pertain to the goals and objectives of all of WHEDco's youth programs.

## **Qualifications:**

- Demonstrated interest in the field of illustration, cartooning, design, education, and/or child development.
- Experience teaching illustration, cartooning, drawing or similar.

- Position requires availability from 4:00-5:00 Monday through Thursday as well for paid preparation time outside of program hours, starting in mid-January 2017 and running through the end of June 2018.
- Familiarity with literacy and whole language teaching methodology desirable.
- Well organized, able to work both independently and collaboratively.
- Bilingual (English/Spanish) a plus.
- Current, active college enrollment or college degree preferred.
- Previous work experience in low-income communities preferred.
