Job Summary: Under the direct supervision of the program director, the **dance instructor** will plan, organize, and implement a dance program for kindergarten through second grade with special attention to skill development, technique, exposure to various dance forms and styles, and safety. Activities should strengthen the self-esteem, practice design process and skills, foster positive expression and enhance personal growth of program participants.

Responsibilities:

- Under the supervision of the program director and working in conjunction with other staff, develop and implement a K-1st grade dance program.
- Lead classes that encourage active participation, foster positive expression and builds self-esteem and personal growth.
- Create lesson plans; select necessary supplies.
- Attend all necessary staff development trainings.
- Attend all required staff/planning meetings.
- Take on special assignments, as needed, which pertain to the goals and objectives of all of WHEDco's youth programs.

Qualifications:

- Minimum of two years' professional experience working with children in a classroom, after school, or community based environment leading/organizing dance activities.
- Familiarity with the principles of dance instruction.
- Able to work Mondays and Wednesdays from 9:30am- 2:00pm beginning July 8, 2019 through August 7, 2019, as well as devote time to curriculum planning and preparation outside of program hours. Additionally, must attend orientation on June 27, 2019 and have flexibility for an end of summer presentation the week of August 12, 2019 (details TBD).
- Well organized, able to work both independently and collaboratively.
- Bilingual (English/Spanish) a plus.
- Current, active college enrollment or college degree preferred.

• Previous work experience in low-income communities preferred.
