**Job Summary:** Under the direct supervision of the program director, the **dance instructor** will plan, organize, and implement two dance programs; one for kindergarten and first grade, and one for a 3rd-8th grade mixes group. Both programs will be designed with special attention to skill development, technique, exposure to various dance forms and styles, and safety. Activities should strengthen the self-esteem, practice design process and skills, foster positive expression and enhance the personal growth of program participants.

## **Responsibilities:**

- Under the supervision of the program director, and working in conjunction with other staff, develop and implement a K-1st grade and 3rd-8th grade dance program.
- Lead classes that encourage active participation, foster positive expression and build selfesteem and personal growth.
- Create lesson plans and select necessary supplies.
- Attend all necessary staff development trainings.
- Attend all required staff and planning meetings.
- Take on special assignments, as needed, which pertain to the goals and objectives of all of WHEDco's youth programs.

## **Qualifications:**

- Minimum two years' professional experience working with children in a classroom, afterschool, or community based environment leading or organizing dance activities.
- Familiarity with the principles of dance instruction.
- Able to work Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays from 2:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. (beginning October 15, 2019 through June 2020) and devote time to curriculum planning and preparation outside of program hours. Additionally, must attend orientation (date TBD).

- Well-organized, able to work both independently and collaboratively.
- Bilingual (English and Spanish) a plus.
- Current, active college enrollment or college degree preferred.
- Previous work experience in low-income communities preferred.

Competitive hourly rate based on experience. This is a part-time, hourly position.
